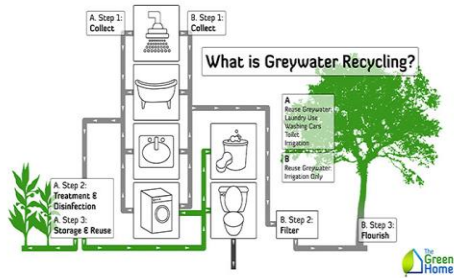


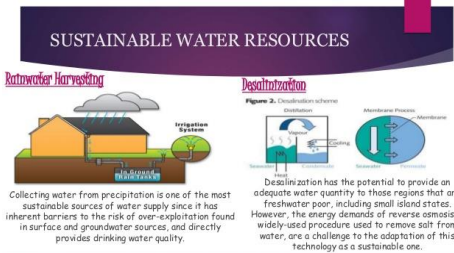
'Grey' water

Wastewater from homes that can be recycled. Uses include water for laundry and toilet flushing.



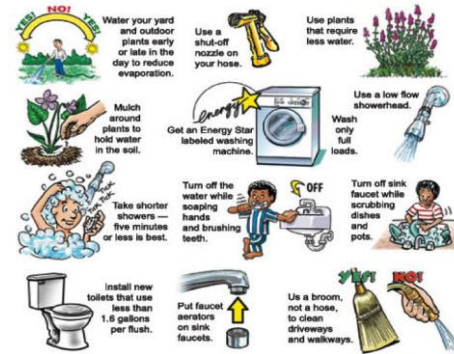
Sustainable water supply

Meeting the need for safe, reliable, and affordable water, whilst ensuring supplies for the future.



Water conservation

The preservation, control and development of water resources.



Water deficit

This exists where water demand is greater than supply.



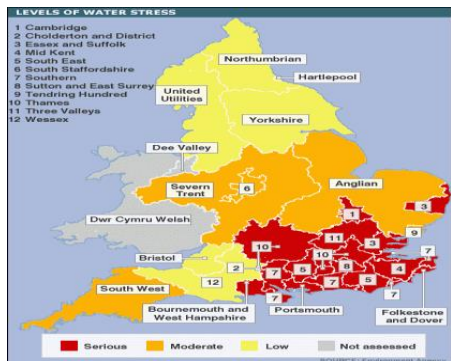
Water security

Reliable availability of water for health, livelihoods and production.



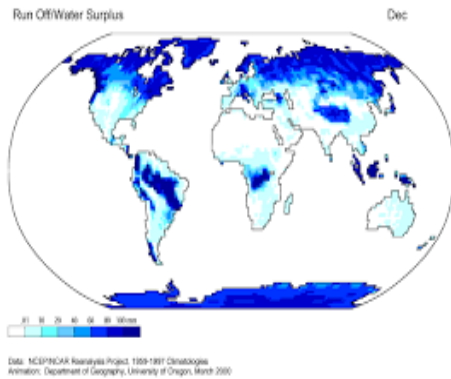
Water stress

Water stress occurs when the demand for water exceeds the available amount.



Water surplus

This exists where water supply is greater than demand.



Water transfer

Water transfer schemes make up for water shortages by transporting water from one to another.



Over-abstraction

When water is being used more quickly that it is being replaced.



Water conflict

Conflicts arise from the gap between growing demands and supplies of water getting smaller.
