Keeping Children Safe in Education.

all school staff must read part one of the guidance, as a minimum. Part one outlines what school and college staff should know and do in relation to safeguarding. Safeguarding is defined in paragraph 4 as:

protecting children from maltreatment; preventing impairment of children's health or development; ensuring that children grow up in circumstances consistent with the provision of safe and effective care; and taking action to enable all children to have the best outcomes.
